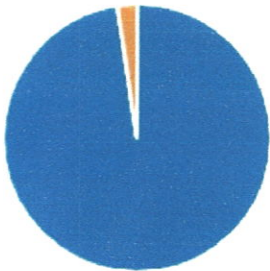


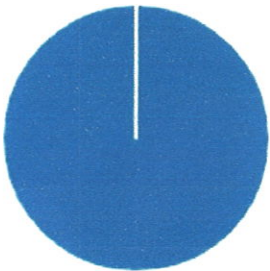

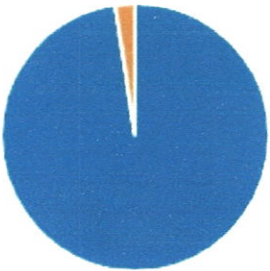

3. Despite the difficult year, my child has made good progress



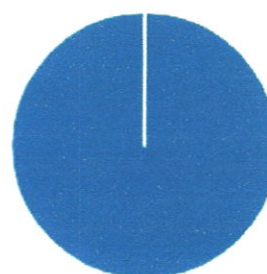

I am very pleased with Morton School and its staff, I think you have done a wonderful job teaching both my children, thank you very much.

My child leaves this year as being in year 6 both my children have attended this school with no problems at all such a fab school thank you all so much for the many years of education. Although I have answered yes to the above questions, I have been very disappointed over the last term. I know you are restricted in what you can do due to covid, but I feel much more could have been done for the current Year 6 who finish at primary school this summer. They have missed out on so much school over the last two years but have spent the last 3 weeks helping teachers get ready for the new term in September. I would have expected them to be doing school work right up until the end of terms to try and catch up on some of what they have missed while schools were closed. There are also missed messages for the children at times. One of my children was told they were unable to bring a reading book from home and had to choose a school book. But then a couple of weeks later children are allowed to bring fidget toys to play with... why a toy but not a reading book.

I have always been happy with the school and whilst my children are doing well and mostly enjoy school, I do feel disappointed for those due to leave this year.

Although not always happy in school any concerns are dealt with in a timely manner.
