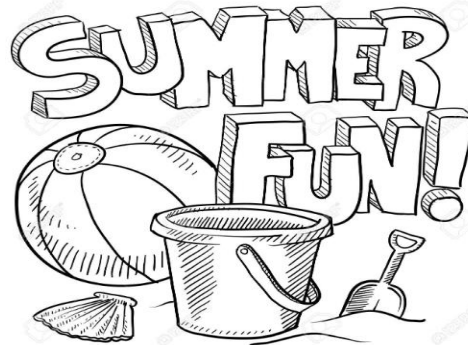
Music – Djembe Drums

This term we have the Lincolnshire Music Service delivering Djembe drum lessons to Year 2...we shall be inviting parents and carers in later in the term to perform for you.

PSHE – Economic Wellbeing – Pupils will learn where money comes from, look at how bank accounts are used and to appreciate the difference between wants and needs.

Maths – Statistics and problem solving using efficient methods are our focuses this half term.

We will also continue our daily multiplication challenge to build fluency of our 10s, 5s, 2s and 3s.



RE – Christianity - Thankfulness

In RE we will be continuing to explore the idea of Thankfulness in Christianity and how this is shown through other world religions too.

Computing – Word Processing

Children will become familiar with word processing and the functions of a keyboard. This will culminate in children creating various text types on a computer.

Science – Materials and their properties

Children will continue to develop their understanding of materials and their properties. They will work scientifically to set up fair tests. They will be using their knowledge of various materials and their properties to make predictions and write up conclusions after carrying out their tests.

Art – 3D Sculptures

In our Art lessons, we will be learning to work with Clay. We will be learning to change the shape of the clay with our hands, make and erase marks on it and join pieces together. At the end, we will have made our own clay tiles inspired by the work of sculptor Rachel Whiteread.

Geography – We will be studying what it is like to live by the coast. This will include studying the coast of the UK and incorporate opportunities for pupils to share their own experiences of visiting the coast.
