KS1 Compulsory Unit: Being Human (Christianity)

Suggestions for Teaching and Learning

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The questions we might ask:

- *What does the Bible say about how Christians should treat others and live their lives?*
- *How might Christian beliefs inspire the actions of inspirational individuals?*

Types of knowledge you might include (*substantive, disciplinary, personal* – see below):

- Christian belief that humans are created by God in his image (**Genesis 1:26-27**)
- Christian belief that humans are created to look after God's creation
- Christian belief that humans should love God and love their neighbour as themselves (**Mark 12:30-31**)
- Examples of this in the Gospels, e.g. the parable of the Good Samaritan, Lost Son, Lost Sheep (*see also God - Christianity*)
- Examples of people who live like this, e.g. Mary (**Luke 1:46-55**), Peter, Paul
