

### English

We will write a wish story based on 'One Sweet Too Far' by Pie Corbett, using the Talk 4 Writing description toolkit. We will also investigate how to write a non-chronological report using the T4W text 'The Manchester Ridgeback' and write recipes.

### Art/DT
