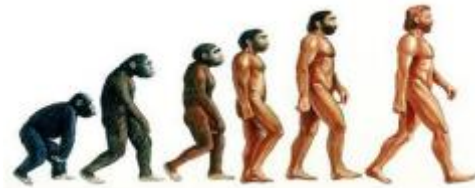
Welcome to Year 6!

PSHE

This term we will be focussing on Safety First. We will look at personal responsibility, peer pressure and risk assessment.

Maths

RE

Our topic this term will be Christianity. The focus will be on the Life Journey of Christians.

Science
