This term is light. We will learn about how light travels; how we see objects; and investigate how light and shadows relate to one another.

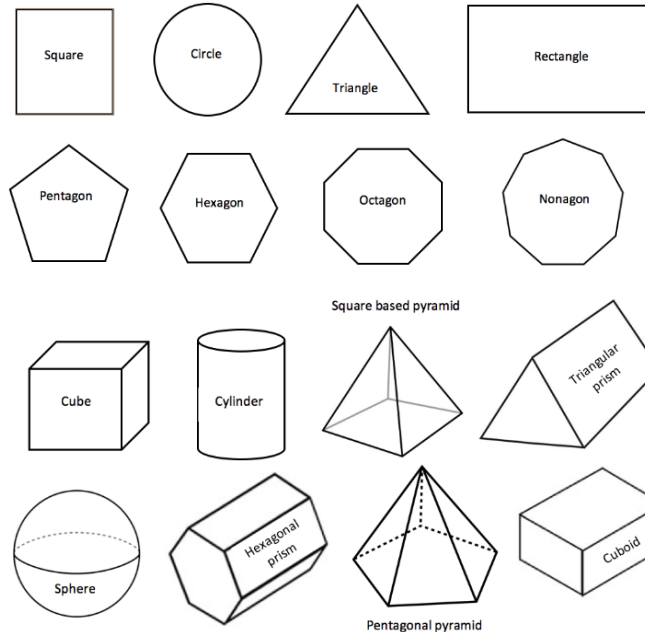
Art
